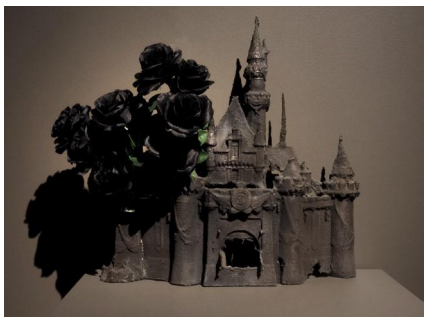


Party Animals!
