

Hooray – we're underway!

The redevelopment of Whanganui's much-loved Sarjeant Gallery is now underway and you'll see lots of activity in Pukenamu Queen's Park until its completion in 2022.



Curious? Here's what's happening over the next few weeks:

Construction of a barrier fence ensures the redevelopment site and surrounding area is kept tidy and safe. The fence goes all the way around the Sarjeant Gallery and the site of the new wing.

As it's always safer for pedestrians and public parking to be completely separated from heavy vehicles, the existing Davis Library carpark will be set aside for the contractor's project office and site vehicles for the project's duration.

The Davis Library loading bay and accessible parks will still be available, including those to the left of the Gallery and outside the Alexander Heritage Library. 3 The walkway from Bell Street to

Queen's Park will also be closing.
