**Star Gossage:**

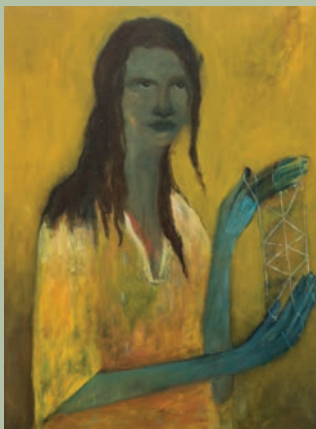
***He Tangata The People***
